

Technical Bulletin: LIDS Download Limit Increases to 325 MB

Data Class Affected: Structured Data Classes and Packaged Products

Change Effective Date: May 12, 2008

Overview: The LIDS download limit has increased from 100 MB to 325 MB. Data product files (SNIF packages) less than 325MB can be downloaded if the 'Download' option is chosen in the 'Select delivery method' selection in LIDS.

Action Required: None

User Impact: Users can now download data product files up to 325 MB. Previously orders between 100 and 325 MB were mailed to subscribers on CD. Users with limited bandwidth can request files can request shipment via mail of orders up to 325 MB using the 'Shipped' option. All orders greater than 325 MB are mailed to users.
