

Technical Bulletin: Change to the Traditional Land Use Area Data Class in the LIO Warehouse

Data Class Affected: Traditional Land Use Area

Change Effective Date: January 9, 2007

Overview: An optional 'Activity Flag' attribute has been added to this data class as a result of a NRVIS enhancement request from a MNR District Office.

The Activity Flag may be assigned a status of:

Active: The feature is actively used/visited by people on a regular or seasonal basis.

Inactive: The feature has not been used/visited by people for an extended period of time (e.g.: 2+ years).

Action Required:

Users should re-order the Traditional Land Use Area data class.
